### Photo consent:

**Information Sharing Consent:**

**Sharing Information with other settings and Professionals:**

The EYFS states that "providers should maintain a regular two-way flow of information between providers (for example, where the child regularly collect the child from nursery).

We aim to meet this requirement by (with permission from parents):

- Asking parents to give permission for other settings/professionals to contact us
- Sharing details about our activities with other settings
- Sharing any learning, development, behaviour or other concerns we have about the child's progress when we have completed the two year old check.
- Asking other settings about the child's activities so we can complement them.
- Requesting information about the child's Learning and Development progress.
- Sharing the child's Learning Journey.
- Forming a good working relationship with the child's keyworker.
- Forming good working relationships with other professionals involved in the child's care.

**Sharing with other agencies:**

I am committed to supporting every child and I am ready to work with other professionals within other agencies so we can give each child the best support possible. Please let us know if your child's care/development is being monitored by another agency, we will need their details so we can speak to them. Also, please give them my details, so they can copy me in to any reports.

- I give consent for Katy's Helping Hands to share information with other settings and professionals. I understand that if a safeguarding incident was to occur, I am obliged to share information about this without gaining your consent first, if I feel that this would put the child at further risk of harm.
- I give consent for my child's personal information (eg, name, dob, medical or dietary requirements, photo, etc) to be left in a sealed envelope with the emergency carer (as per my emergency plan) and on outings when it is the child's best interests to do so.

## OTHER CONSENTS

Please tick each box to confirm your consent.

- I agree for the child named below to go on routine outings with the childminder, such as to the library, park, woods, toddler groups, school, soft play, picnics, visiting friends, community visits, cafes, feeding the ducks, etc, with or without your prior knowledge.
- I give permission for the use of buggies, reins, slings, walking, as necessary when out and about.
- I agree for the child named below to use play equipment in gardens, parks or playgrounds while in the care of the childminder named below. This includes climbing apparatus, trampolines, and bouncy castles, bike/trikes/scooters, etc.
- I agree for the child named below to go special outings to, for example the zoo or farm. I acknowledge that the childminder will inform me of these ahead of time, and may request a voluntary donation towards these.
- I agree for the childminder to transport my child in her vehicle. She will ensure it is appropriately maintained and insured, and that the child is seated in an appropriate car seat.
- I will/will not provide a car seat suitable to my child's needs.
- I give permission for my child to travel on public transport, including buses, trains and taxis or other vehicles.
- I give permission for emergency contact information to be carried with us on outings, including child's photo, name, emergency contact details, and medical needs.
- I give permission for intimate care to be provided, including nappy changes, toileting support, and washing as required if the child is unwell or has a nappy explosion.
- I give permission for you to support my child to wash his hands using single use cloths and antibacterial soap. When we cannot access water, we will use baby wipes and alcohol gel.
- I give permission for my child to sleep in a flat buggy, travel cot, or on a floor mat, depending on the time of day and their preference. Children will not be left sleeping in car seats once we have returned from an outing, due to the risk of positional asphyxia.
- I give permission for my child to come in to supervised contact with our cats.
- Outside play is an important part of children's learning and development and it a requirement of the EYFS to enable children to play outside every day. I will provide suitable clothes for the weather conditions, including waterproofs, hats/gloves, warm clothes for winter and cool, lightweight clothes for summer. I acknowledge these may get messy.



# Katy's Helping Hands

- I agree for sun protection cream to be applied to the below-named child by the childminder named below. I will provide the suncream I wish to be applied to my child, and will label the bottle with my child's name.
- I have read the behaviour management policy and the physical intervention policy.
- I agree that I will not send my child in if s/he is not well enough to participate in the day to day activities of the setting. There is a 48 hour exclusion period for sickness and diarrhoea, and Katy's Helping Hands will take advice from the HPA regarding other common illnesses.
- Physical intervention comes in many forms. On a day to day basis, this could be cuddling your child, carrying them, holding their hand, supporting them to walk or help them complete a task hand over hand. For some children, they may need physical support to help them access a learning opportunity. Other children may need physical restraint in order to protect themselves from harm, to protect others from harm or to prevent damage to property. I give permission for Katy's Helping Hands to physically intervene in an appropriate manner to the situation. I understand that any incidents of physical restraint will be recorded and shared with me.
